# Project Development (I)

- Urbanization: Reactive or Proactive?
- Reactive: basic deficiency in delivery, decentralized
- Proactive: engine of growth, futuristic, strategic, city-region/corridor
- Link between urban planning and government fiscal/budget planning
  - Use of central assistance – grant/loan/guarantees
  - State of assistance – fiscal transfer/state-level financial intermediaries

# Project Development (II)

- Adopt a City/ADB Partnership
  - Select cities for 10-15 year partnership
  - Assess cluster city economic development potential (vertical or horizontal)
  - Upgrade CDPs
  - Feasibility studies
  - Review and adopt PPP, where feasible
  - ADB financing (sovereign and non-sovereign)/ market instruments

# Financing

- Project loans at the state level
- Financial intermediary loan at the state level
- Project development facility at the national level (ADB loan-financed)
- Policy loan to MOUD
- Policy loan to states (?)

# Implementation and Institutionalization

- State nodal agencies
- Sharing experience of PMUs for ADB-financed projects
- Institutionalization of concept to execution
- Company or Society to host financial intermediation and project development
